Liability:

The participant is responsible for insurance. The organiser and federation are not liable. With registration, the participant and dojo director confirm the participant's physical and mental health.

Equipment:

A white karate gi and a club badge on the left chest are permitted. Bandages must be approved by the refereeing committee. Participants wear contact lenses at their own risk.

Compulsory for Kumite:

Fist protectors white - type ESKA (maximum 3 cm thick) - **Gum shield**

Permitted for Kumite: groin protectors, chest protectors for female competitors.

Not permitted: Shin guards.

Rules and System: ESKA and Swiss Ippon Shobu rules

Double starts are allowed as follows:

- Youths aged 14/15 may compete in Cadets Kata categories (**but not in Kumite**).
- Cadets aged 16/17 may compete in Juniors Kata and Kumite categories.
- Juniors aged 18, 19, 20 may compete in Seniors Kata and Kumite categories.

International Senior Kumite Categories

For seniors with international experience (who have already competed in ESKA-WSKA or similar tournaments). Athletes can choose which category they wish to compete in.

Note: Double starts are not permitted! Athletes competing in the international kumite categories cannot compete in any other individual kumite categories. Exception: Senior Team Kumite.

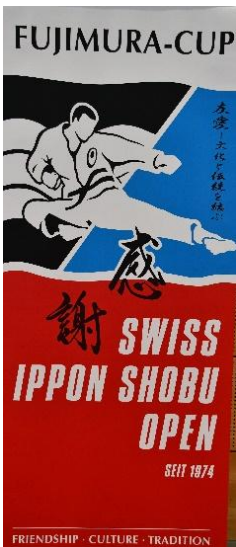
